Alcoholic Beverages will be served from 11:00 am to 10:00 pm

- A maximum of one drink will be served at any given time.
- Mini Bar, Bootlegger Café Barista & Room Service are not included in the Package. Any consumption will be charged as à la carte.
- Guests booked on the All-Inclusive Meal Plan can avail a 50% discount on Food & Beverages in all outlets except In Room Dining, & Café Barista.
No discount will be applicable on special bundle offers and promotions.

Terms and Conditions for All-Inclusive Package

- Alcoholic Beverages: Guests understand that, as per local laws, there might be a ban on serving alcohol on certain days. This is beyond the hotel's control, and therefore, customers agree not to seek any compensation or rebate if such an event occurs. Note that this ban typically lasts for 24 hours.
